Dear Parents/Guardians:

We are accepting applications for **limited** openings in the Huron School District for the fall 2024-2025 school year. You must reside within a Wayne County School District in order to apply for an opening. Please be advised of the following:

- Applications will only be accepted between April 28, 2024 through May 15, 2024, 4:00 p.m. and will be available at the Administration building or may be printed from the website www.huronschools.org. **Incomplete information will not be accepted and will automatically be disqualified.**
- If we receive more applications than openings for each grade level, a random lottery will be held.
- Applications of students who have been suspended or expelled within the past two school years will automatically disqualify your student's application.
- A copy of the student's **last report card** which shows attendance and grades, **must** be turned in with all applications for **grades 1 through 8**.
- If you are applying for a vacancy in grades 6-12 you **must** have the "Affirmation of Prior Discipline" form signed by you, your student, and the student's current building principal to accompany their application. Incomplete forms will disqualify the application.
- If you are applying for grades 9-12 your student must have earned enough credits to be at the grade level that they are applying for. An **unofficial transcript** and a copy of their **last report card** which shows attendance must accompany their application. Failure to provide this information will disqualify the application.
- If you are applying for grades 9-12, please know that incoming freshman are eligible to play athletics for Huron. 10-12th graders may be penalized from participating in athletics for a period of time. If you have any questions regarding this matter, please contact your current Athletic Director, or you may contact the Huron School District Athletic Director, at 734-783-0324.
- ***Completed applications and all documentation can be submitted between April 28, 2024 through May 15, 2024 4:00 p.m. They can be mailed to the address listed above or emailed to: schoolofchoice@huronschools.org. Any application that is received or post-marked outside of this window, will be disqualified. For your convenience a drop-off box will be outside of the Board Office, Monday-Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.***

2. There will be no tuition or other enrollment costs associated with SOC students attending HSD other than those costs that are expected of all students attending HSD.
3. SOC students are expected to adhere to all rules and regulations, the Student Code of Conduct, and policies of HSD. In addition, they must comply with all SOC legislative rules and regulations.
4. Students who have been expelled from any school district and/or school, public or private, are not eligible for enrollment in HSD.
5. **THE HURON SCHOOL DISTRICT WILL NOT PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION FOR SCHOOL OF CHOICE STUDENTS**
6. School of Choice students who are determined to be eligible for special education programming will be subject to the same placement procedures as resident District students and may be placed in appropriate programs outside the Huron School District in accordance with the Special Education cooperative agreement. **If the applying student has an IEP, it must be attached to the application.**

FAQ's

- Should I include a birth certificate or immunization record with my application?
 - No, please do not include any other documents other than what is required for the grade level that you are applying for.
- When will I know if my child has been accepted?
 - Letters will go out to everyone during the last week of May. If your child was accepted, you will be given instructions with a deadline, on how to enroll your child.
- What if my child doesn't get accepted?
 - All valid applications, that are not selected during the lottery process, are placed on a waitlist. If space becomes available, you will be contacted by phone regarding enrollment. This will take place during the end of August.
- Can I pick the elementary building I would like my child to attend?
 - Unfortunately, we cannot guarantee a specific building for elementary grades. One building may have more availability than the other. We always take your location into consideration prior to selecting the elementary building.
- Once my child is accepted, do I have to apply every year?
 - No, once your child is accepted, they can remain in Huron Schools, however if you must always reside within the Wayne County School District boundary lines to remain at Huron.
- Do their siblings automatically get in?
 - Every student must apply and be accepted through the School of Choice application process. Having siblings that already attend, does not guarantee acceptance for a new sibling that is trying to apply.
- How do I get signed up for a bus route?
 - The parents of School of Choice students must provide their own transportation for their students. Our buses are not allowed to pick up within other districts.
- I am looking at building a house in Wayne County, can I still apply?
 - You must reside within the Wayne County school district boundary lines. If you have the certificate of occupancy, you can apply. You will have 30 days to update your proof of residency information.
